

# VITP – Single Elimination game between Joe Dragan and Nathan Zietlow

Nathan is playing IJN with a bid of 4.5 using options 1 and 2.

Turn 1 – Two BB’s escape Pearl, Tennessee with 3 damage and Oklahoma with 1. Both British BB’s survive. The POW with 3 damage. All 5 of my carriers show up on the West coast. The I-Boat sinks the Hermes.

Turn 2 -



Nathan gets his desired night in the Aleutians but I get night in USM, where I have a lap of 5 ships. I sink Shokaku, Zuikaku and Hiryu in USM and Shoho in the Aleutians in round 1. I-Boat hits Lexington for 2 damage. New Mexico is maxed in the USM and sent to Pearl at the end of the turn. We each sink 4 cruisers total throughout the board. I sink Mutsu and Nagato in pursuit day actions in the USM. IJN POC is at 15.

Turn 3



With the attrition situation in my favor, I decide to play conservatively and not gamble on losing my Marines to the 58% probability of a night or day/night in Hawaii. I figure that my 6 LBA should be able to sink or disable most if not all of Nathan's 7 carriers and allow my 4 BB,s and Marines to teleport out of Pearl. Ultimately I disable Akagi and Kaga (with 3d), sink the other 5 carriers and shoot down 2 LBA. At the beginning of round 5, we each have one LBA left. Nathan avoids a total disaster and shoots down my last LBA and converts Pearl. IJN POC is at 18.
